2021-22 Headphone Requirements

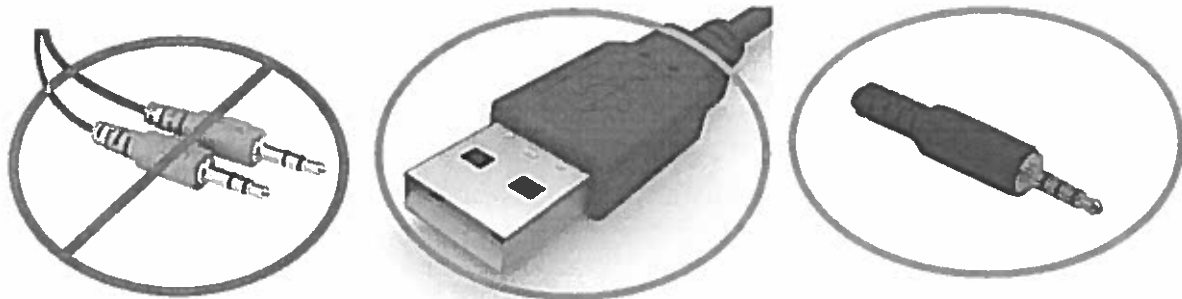


We will be implementing a new program this fall. The program is provided by the Northwest Education Association (NWEA), a non-profit organization that researches and develops assessment solutions for schools. We currently use the NWEA Measure of Academic Progress Assessment (MAP) at Lakeview.

The new program is called MAP Reading Fluency. Students read into a microphone and the program measures their reading rate and asks them a few questions to measure their reading comprehension. It records their reading so that their teachers can listen to them at a later time. In the case of our youngest students who are not yet reading passages, the program assesses foundational skills such as their sight word knowledge and picture vocabulary.

Students will need a set of headphones with an attached boom microphone to use the program. We will provide each classroom with headphones, which will be sanitized between uses by different students. However, if you would prefer that your child not share headphones you can purchase a set of headphones that will meet these requirements:

- Attached boom microphone (not an in-line microphone)
- Single 3.5mm plug or USB plug



Our PTO is going to make a bulk purchase of them to secure a lower price, and will resell them to families this fall. We do not have a cost finalized at this time, but believe it will be in the range of \$10-\$15.

Please note that all students need headphones for a variety of programs that are used on the Chromebooks. If you choose to purchase headphones without an attached boom microphone we will provide your child with a set to use for the MAP Fluency Assessment.

Lakeview Kindergarten Supply List

- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 pair of scissors(blunt end)
- 1 box of #2 pencils sharpened (**Ticonderoga brand**).
- 4 containers of Play-Doh (regular size and any color).
- 4 CRAYOLA 16 packs of crayons, no glitter or fluorescent.

- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 3 – 2 pocket **vinyl** folders- **red, blue** and **green**.

- 1 plastic medium size pencil box. They have these at Walmart for 97 cents, **Sterilite** brand holds up very well.
- 1 pair of **STURDY** headphones **with a microphone**(NO EAR BUDS). Please see the note that will be sent home with the report card.
- 1- 9 x 13 cookie sheet. The Dollar Tree has them for \$1.00.
- Boys- 1 box of quart size zip-lock baggies; please purchase baggies with the tab (slide lock) for closure; the tab is easy for kindergartners to use.
- Boys- 1 8-pack of Crayola Washable Markers-THICK
- Girls—2 Pink Pearl Erasers
- Girls- 1 box of gallon size zip-lock baggies; please purchase baggies with the tab (slide lock) for closure; the tab is easy for kindergartners to use.

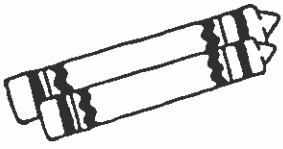
Please bring supplies listed above to kindergarten orientation.

This supply list is what every kindergarten student should have at the start of the year. Your child's teacher will send home supply items that will be needed that are specific to their class the night of kindergarten orientation.

Lakeview Supplies for First Grade

- Book bag or backpack (no wheels)
- Pencil box (not bag) with name printed on outside
- 6 ELMERS glue sticks
- 1 pair of Scissors (pointed metal blades work best)
- 3- (16 to 24 count) crayons (no glitter or fluorescent)
- 6 thick **black** dry erase markers- low odor (no colored markers)
- 2 sturdy pocket folders (plastic lasts the longest) with name written in the outside
- 1 box of #2 sharpened pencils (no mechanical)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1-2 Coloring or activity book for indoor recess (with name written on the outside)
- 2 highlighters
- 2 red pens and 2 green pens (for Writer's Workshop)
- 2 large pink erasers
- Headphones with an attached boom microphone & a USB or single 3.5mm plug
- 1 inch binder (with view, any color) write child's name on the cover
- 2 containers of play-doh (any color)
- 1 container of baby wipes and/or Clorox wipes
- sandwich size zipper baggies (boys only)
- zipper gallon size bags (girls only)

***Please unwrap and write your child's name with a permanent marker on their supplies. Supplies seem to dwindle mid-year. Items may need to be replenished at that time. Buy extra while items are on sale!**

SUPPLY LIST

Please note that these are essential supplies that all students in second grade should have by the first week of school. They are for school use and do not need to be fancy.

- 1 pack of 4 black dry erase markers
- 1 old sock to use as dry erase marker eraser
- 2 packs of crayons (24)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 pack of pink erasers
- 12 glue sticks
- 3 packs of sharpened Ticonderoga pencils (regular)
- 2 box of tissues
- 2 highlighters
- 3 durable (heavy duty) plastic pocket folders
- 3 one-subject spiral notebooks
- 1 large* pencil pouch for supplies.
- 1 set headphones WITH EMBEDDED MICROPHONE
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters. Rulers that are clear plastic and start with a 0 are easier to use. (**NOT** bendable)
- GiRLS**- 1 box of sandwich sized baggies
- BOYS**- 1 box of gallon sized baggies

We have limited space in classrooms. Please DO NOT purchase trappers, large tri-fold binders, or any non-essential item until your child's teacher has informed you of their supply policy. We do not want you to spend money on items that are not necessary. You may want to purchase extra crayons, glue sticks, pencils and dry erase markers while they are on sale for later in the year.

Third Grade Supply List

Please note that these are essential supplies that all students in third grade should have by the first week of school. They are for school use and do not need to be fancy.

- **2 packs of 4 dry erase markers (black)**
- **1 old sock to use as a dry erase marker eraser**
- **1 pack of colored pencils**
- **3 packs of crayons**
- **1 pair of scissors**
- **4 glue sticks**
- **2 packs of sharpened pencils**
- **1 box of tissues for each semester**
- **1 highlighter**
- **3 heavy-duty pocket folders** (please put name on each and label one "stay at school", one "take-home", and the other won't have a label)
- **2 spiral, one-subject notebooks** (please put name on each one)
- **2 composition notebooks**
- **1 set of earbuds or headphones** (see note below)
- **Plastic Zipper Bags:** **Girls: bring 1 box of quart sized bags**
Boys: bring 1 box gallon sized bags
- **1 pack disinfectant wipes**
- **2 one-inch, three-ring view binders** (solid color labeled with name)
- **1 pack of wide-ruled, loose leaf filler paper**
- **1 pack of multiplication/division flash cards**
- **1 large, cloth, zippered, pencil pouch**
- **1 personal pencil sharpener** (with lid to catch shavings)
- **1 personal dry erase board** (There is an 8.5 x 11" one at Dollar Tree for \$1.00)
- **1 LARGE book bag** (students may be carrying all items in book bags)

Headphones: All K-4 students will be starting a new fluency program this year in reading. The program requires students to read aloud into their computer, so headphones with a boom microphone will be necessary. Teachers will have a couple of sets for students to share. If you wish for your son/daughter to use their own, instead of buying standard earbuds, you can purchase headphones with a 3.5mm plug or a USB plug. An example of this type would be the [iClever Kids Headphones with Microphone](#), which can be found on Amazon for \$13.59.

*Please do not purchase any non-essential item until your child's teacher has informed you of their supply policy. We do not want you to spend money on items that will not be necessary.
