School Bus Regulations
(Please read carefully)

The behavior of students on a school bus affects the safe operation of that bus. The unsafe operation comes about as a result of the driver being distracted by poor behavior of students. The following are examples of unacceptable behavior that leads to poor bus safety conditions:

These and other acts of poor behavior which affect school bus safety will not be accepted. Corrective action will be taken in the interest of total bus safety. Violations will be reported to the building principal. If necessary, bus privileges will be terminated.
