Dear Parent:

Lakeview High School's final exam format for grades 9-11 places an educational focus on the end of the school year. Exams will be 90 minutes in length thus providing a more authentic measure of student performance. The seniors graduate on May 22nd and will not be in the building May 24th - 26th. Seniors will not participate in this schedule. May 24th is a required full day for students with an early dismissal option for study hall students during an exam period.

- Students will report to school for their first scheduled exam of the day. Students will not be permitted to enter and/or exit the building during the 90 minute exam with the exception of lunch (please see the exam schedule included).
- Students will report to school 5 minutes prior to a scheduled exam on the 25th/26th of May. Students will not be permitted to roam the halls, call upon teachers, go to the K-8, enter or leave the building during exams.
- Once a student has completed their final exam(s) for the day, he/she may leave school at the end of the exam period pending parent permission form signed.
- The cafeteria will be open for breaks between exams for students to "power up" on nourishment.
- The cafeteria will be open as usual on May 24th & 25th. In addition, room 115 study hall will be open and monitored.
- Grades 9-11 will be permitted open lunch privileges on May 25th, but may use the cafeteria option as well. Students (9-11) using the open lunch option will not be permitted to loiter on school property. Students will not be permitted back into the building until 11:55 a.m.
