

Lakeview Local Schools Board of Education will permit the enrollment of students who are residents of other school districts in Ohio. Students wishing to enroll in Lakeview Schools may do so within the scope of the policies and regulations adopted by the Lakeview Local Schools Board of Education as pertaining to Policy 5113 – Inter-District Open Enrollment.

The following guidelines for the enrollment of students are based upon criteria established by the schools' administration in conjunction with recommendations of the Ohio Department of Education. These guidelines are consistent with applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

1. The enrollment period for open enrollment is between March 1 and March 31, 2023. Requests for students in open grades 1st-12th grades will be acted upon (approved or denied) by May 5, 2023, with parental acceptance of transfer on or before May 12, 2023. By May 26, 2023, any applicant that has been notified of acceptance must have completed the registration process or attendance will be denied. If grade, building and program capacities have not been exceeded, enrollment privileges may be extended by the superintendent and/or designee until capacity has been met.
2. No open enrollment will be permitted if the enrollment being requested exceeds the following:
 - a) Grade K: 110 per grade level
 - b) Grade 1: 115 per grade level
 - c) Grade 2: 115 per grade level
 - d) Grade 3: 115 per grade level
 - e) Grade 4: 115 per grade level
 - f) Grade 5: 115 per grade level
 - g) Grade 6: 115 per grade level
 - h) Grade 7: 120 per grade level
 - i) Grade 8: 120 per grade level
 - j) Grade 9: 125 per grade level
 - k) Grade 10: 125 per grade level
 - l) Grade 11: 125 per grade level
 - m) Grade 12: 125 per grade level
 - n) Grades K-12: Special Education – 6 less than state maximum

The Board reserves the right to reduce these capacities as necessary in cases of unusually low resident enrollment at grade level(s).

3. No student, once accepted by Lakeview Local Schools Board of Education, will be displaced that year should enrollment exceed the above-stated limits. All approved enrollments are in effect for the current school year only and may be discontinued at the discretion of the participating board of education in subsequent years.
4. Applications shall be considered on a first-come, first-served basis (date/time of receipt) with an assurance that the following order for placement will be followed:
 - a) Lakeview resident students will not be displaced.
 - b) Students currently attending Lakeview Local Schools pursuant to the inter-district open enrollment policy per capacity limits.
 - c) First-time open enrollment students.
5. Enrollment will be denied to students who have been suspended or expelled for 10 consecutive days in the current term or the immediately preceding term.
6. Open enrollment may be discontinued at the discretion of the Lakeview Local Schools Board of Education.
